As of this date, _____, we, the General Contractor and Electrical Contractor hereinafter referred to as the Undersigned, do hereby acknowledge, that in addition to providing the general power to the building and facilities at the Job Location, the electrical system is intended to power sensitive computer equipment and cash registers used in the restaurant at the point of sale (the "POS system"), and that such POS system may be damaged and/or fail as a result of wiring and/or electrical maintenance deficiencies that may occur if the electrical system is not installed in strict compliance with the construction documents as hereinafter defined. Therefore, in affirmation that the electrical system at the Job Location has been installed in full compliance with the Construction Documents, we each hereby certify:

- 1) That I have reviewed all of the Construction Documents which are defined to include but are not limited to all; contracts, plans, specifications, drawings, manuals, bid documents and the Power Quality Troubleshooting Guide ("PQTS Guide" developed to minimize the risk of poor power quality) that are directly or indirectly related to the electrical systems for the Job Location, (collectively referred to as the "Construction Documents"); and
- 2) That I have reviewed the PQTS guide which sets forth the skill and expertise required of an "Electrician" who is qualified to install the electrical service to power the POS system at the above Job Location ("Qualified Electrician"); and
- 3) That the electrical service powering the POS system has been properly installed by a Qualified Electrician; and
- 4) That all electrical work, electrical service and electrical systems, materials and labor for which the Undersigned are directly or indirectly responsible have been properly installed in full compliance with all Construction Documents and all NFPA, building, electrical and other applicable codes.
- 5) That the Electrician checklist & visual guide for POS based on the PQTS Guide has been completed by a Qualified Electrician.

The Undersigned, jointly and severally warrant and represent that the forgoing certifications are all true and correct as of the date set forth above. We further acknowledge and agree, that if the any of the above certifications are found to be untrue, then we shall be jointly and severally liable to all parties who may claim injury or damages and for reimbursement of all costs and expenses incurred including but not limited to: all material and labor to repair and/or replace damaged machinery, fixtures, equipment, or the entire POS system; bringing the electrical system into compliance with the construction documents; damages that may result to the POS system or any other electrical systems; personal injury; all incidental and consequential damages that relate to the electrical system; and all related attorneys fees and costs.
